

# Amish Quilting & Culture



Learn about Amish culture and history from presenter Julie Tebay, whose knowledge is based on extensive correspondence with Amish coworkers and friends that share a talent for master quilting, many of whom are employed at Quilting Plus, Tebay's hand quilting business.


