GRRL accomplished a number of highly successful programs with Arts & Cultural Heritage Funding in fiscal year 2011. Children from across the region attended a performance of the 'Peter & the Wolf' ballet at the Paramount Theatre in St. Cloud, performed by dancers from Stroia Ballet. Kids, parents, and teachers raved about this event. GREAT Theatre did a wonderful Summer Reading Program tie-in event to kick off the summer, using the "One World, Many Stories" theme. They performed stories from around the world, and compared how there are similar folk tales across continents. Art workshops from a variety of artists (mosaics, mixed media, painting, drawing, etc.) took place across the region. These are some of the most popular Legacy-funded programs, as attendees get to learn a skill and complete a project at the same time. "It's great to have these options for our kids to learn about things they may otherwise not be introduced to," wrote one parent. Another commenter wrote, "Surely appreciate what all Minnesotans can do when we work together. Putting all our pennies together we can build great works!"
