David LaRochelle, author/illustrator residency. The community of Glenwood just fell in love with David LaRochelle. He came to celebrate National Library Week by visiting kindergarten through sixth grade students. Community members were invited to each of his classrooms. He delighted the children with his stories and drawings, many of which he created for specific children and then presented them to take home. His books have been available at the public library only be placing a hold ever since.

Children in the Perham area were given the opportunity to explore four different styles of art in a unique way. After being introduced to impressionism, pointillism, fauvism and cubism, they were instructed to look around the library and through a pile of art books that had been gathered for the occasion to find an example of their favorite style. Then they used various tools and mediums to create a replica of the piece. Each child left

Residents throughout Viking Library System were offered the opportunity to take four consecutive art history classes in towns throughout the region. Artists Lorene McIntosh and Stephen Henning held art history programs for adults and teens. Topics covered were: Greek and Roman art, the Renaissance, and Impressionism. In each program, the work of a local working artist whose style is influenced by the time period was presented. These were scholarly, serious professionally done classes that left a great impression on the people who attended.
